***To be eligible to receive VFC immunizations a child must:**

- ☞ Be 18 years or younger,
- ☞ Have no health insurance, OR
- ☞ Be eligible for Medi-Cal, OR
- ☞ Is Native American or Alaskan Native

- ✓ Parents, please bring a ***printed copy*** of your child's immunization record with you!
- ✓ If a parent/guardian is not present, a proxy caregiver consent form must accompany the child. This form is available on our website: <https://www.mynevadacounty.com/622/Immunization-Consent-Forms>
- ✓ A limited amount of private pay vaccine will be available for purchase.

2018 Ready for School Planning

Parents/Guardians/Caretakers:

In order to be ready for school, we want to encourage you to start early in making sure your child is up-to-date on their immunizations as wait times for these appointments can be several months. Please include your child's health exam, along with all required immunizations in your "ready-for-school" planning.

- ✓ If your child has a Primary Care Provider (PCP), please contact them early to make any necessary appointments for health check-ups and immunizations.
- ✓ For those without a PCP, this is a perfect time to find a doctor to make sure child's health needs and required immunizations can be addressed.
- ✓ The Nevada County Public Health Department will provide immunizations through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program for those who qualify. Eligibility requirements are:
 - Have Medi-Cal, or
 - Are uninsured, or
 - Are American Indian or Alaskan Native

Sample timeline to make sure your child is ready for school.

March – Find a Primary Care Provider and register your child with them.

April – Call to make an appointment for your child's immunizations.

May – Have you made an appointment? If not, call now!

June – It may already be too late to get an appointment before school starts. Call now!

July – Keep your appointment! Get your child's health checkup and immunizations.

August – School starts! Is your child ready?
